³ Short-Term Camp: Only adults may use cots. Long-Term Camp: Adults and Scouts may use cots. All cots must have rounded legs to prevent damage to the floors of Troop tents. No x-leg military-style cots.

⁴ Scouts MUST wear closed-toe shoes/slippers. In rainy weather, bring waterproof footwear (Rain Boots).

⁵ Scouts MUST turn-in ALL medications to the Scoutmaster; asthma inhalers and diabetic kits may be carried.

⁶ Use trash bags to keep clothing and sleeping bags dry during wet-weather campouts.
